

2016 Sun Meadow HOA Special Meeting  
June 9, 2019  
7:00pm River Oaks Presbyterian Church

1. Welcome and opening comments by Vice President, Elliot Parker.
2. Secretary, Becky Lowe, confirmed quorum was met.
3. Motion to open meeting by Diane King-Jaynes, second by Patrick Ryan.
4. Introduction of SMHOA Board Members in attendance: Nancy Rausch, President. Elliot Parker, Vice President. Becky Lowe, Secretary. Steve Jaynes, Treasurer. Cynthia Woodson, Member at Large.
5. Question from the audience: "Are the speed humps on the main drag only?" Nancy, replied, "yes".
6. Special guest, Ron Steward, fireman from 111<sup>th</sup> and Yale Fire Department that serves our neighborhood. Ron stated that they Fire Department's stance is safety first. He commented that if there is a speeding problem and humps can slow the traffic and possibly save a child's life then they support the humps. He also stated that respond times to our neighborhood homes is 4 min. He also stated they do have to slow for the humps but, considering that they already go the speed limit in neighborhoods and already have to stop for stop signs, then he doesn't expect respond times to increase by more than a minute. He also said that one minute increase is assumes traveling from Yale side to Sheridan side on the main drag with all of the humps.
7. Cynthia Woodson read a letter from Kelli Bruer, with EMSA. Kelli's letter stated they do not predict delays after hump installation, as they do not speed in neighborhoods.
8. Audience members asked if this vote would supersede the original main drag poll. Nancy answered, "yes". (Meaning if traffic calming were voted down the HOA Board would have to rescind their approval.)
9. Floor opened for questions from the audience with several attendees commenting both in support of the humps and against the installation.
10. Motion to take a vote for/against installation of speed humps on the proposed main drag areas by Steve McFarlin. Second, Trish Bartlett.
11. Motion to close voting after it appeared all ballots were collected. Motion by Mike McCann. Second, Patrick Ryan.
12. Proxy votes and in person votes counted and confirmed by: Patrick Ryan, Becky Lowe and Suzanne Watt.  
Results: 69 Yes for speed humps:  
53 No speed hump
