6:30PM – 8:30PM.**

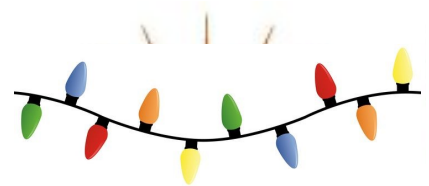

Report Code Violations

All calls remain
anonymous!

Did you know that over 70% of calls made to 9-1-1 come from mobile phones? When you dial 9-1-1 from a mobile phone, the 9-1-1 call takers have very little information to help you – only your phone number and a very general sense of your location.

This does not bode well in an emergency when seconds count, particularly if you or your loved ones have medical conditions, or if there is a fire.

The solution is Smart911! With Smart911, both 9-1-1 call takers and first responders know exactly what you want them to know in any kind of emergency.

With Smart911, you can add key information about members of your household that would help anyone you care for in the event of an emergency, whether the call is from the home or any mobile phone.

- People– names, physical descriptions, photos
- Phones– all phones for your household
- Animals– so first responders can be aware
- Medical Conditions, Allergies and Medications
- Property Details, Utilities, Floor Layout and Bedroom Location– all of which can help ensure everyone is removed from a property quickly and safely
